JOB SUMMARY Director of the Program for the Deaf, Central Region at the Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind. This is an auditory/oral and auditory-verbal program serving children preschool through sixth grade in both classroom and outreach settings. Plans, develops and administers programs that provide and support educational opportunities for students; cooperates with various entities to develop, evaluate and implement curricula which are in compliance with the State Board of Education and meet the needs and interests of students; supervises and evaluates teachers and staff; ensures compliance with state and federal laws for the implementation of IEP or 504 plans; prepares budget and determines allocation of funds for staff, supplies, equipment and facilities; evaluates and modifies teaching methods, support systems and/or community participation in educational and other programs offered at the school; performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS Master's degree in Special Education; possession of, or eligibility for, a State of Utah Teaching License with a Hearing Impairments endorsement, plus an Administrative/Supervisory license. Must have five (5) or more years experience related to administering programs for students/children with hearing impairments. Preference will be given to candidates with LSLS AV certification. In order to drive a State vehicle, incumbent must have and maintain a valid Utah driver license and clean driving record. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position. The starting date for this position will be August 1, 2010.
