JOB SUMMARY Provides direct Orientation & Mobility (O&M) services to blind/visually impaired students, ages 3-21, in a variety of educational settings; provides O&M assessments for students on caseload; provides instruction and consultation in school districts; consults with parents, educators and vision consultants; is responsible for writing progress reports, updating client records, etc.; performs other duties as assigned.

JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS Bachelor=s or Master=s degree with certification in Orientation and Mobility from an accredited college or university. Applicants must be AER certified or have the ability to meet requirements for certification. There are moderate physical requirements, as assisting students with disabilities is an essential function of this position. Must be able to lift and carry up to fifty (50) pounds. This position also requires some physical exertion such as long periods of standing, recurring bending, crouching, stooping, stretching, reaching or similar activities. Some travel is required. Must have and maintain a valid Utah driver license and clean driving record. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position.
