JOB SUMMARY Works with individual deaf and hard-of-hearing students in inclusive settings on an itinerant basis. Plans learning experiences utilizing school curricula, IEP goals and objectives, and other appropriate materials and activities; prepares lesson plans, reports and keeps records of student progress; ascertains learning needs of students in areas of study and uses established evaluation techniques for assessment of progress; improves professional competence through participation in staff development activities and other professional growth activities; performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS Bachelor's degree (required) or Master's degree (preferred) in Special Education; possession of, or eligibility for, a State of Utah Teaching License with a Hearing Impaired endorsement. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position.

SALARY AND BENEFITS Salary based on Teacher Salary Schedule commensurate with education and experience. This position is eligible for full benefits including medical, dental, life insurance, long term disability insurance, 1.5% employer contribution to 401(k), personal and sick leave, pension, and other valuable benefits.
