JOB SUMMARY Performs inspection, preventative maintenance and minor repairs on school-owned equipment and facilities, including plumbing, carpentry, electrical, mechanical devices, interior and exterior buildings and grounds, etc; maintains and performs preventative maintenance on swimming pool and spa facilities to comply with health regulations; performs regular inspection of lighting devices and ensures that all bulbs, fuses, ballasts and other associated parts are functioning properly; moves heavy objects such as furniture, office equipment, etc; performs setup and takedown duties associated with meetings and other school-related functions; paints offices, hallways, etc.; helps to shuttle state-owned vehicles for service; removes snow from sidewalks and doorways, etc. when necessary; performs other duties as assigned. Some travel is required, typically to the Salt Lake City and Orem areas.

JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS Knowledge of electrical and mechanical systems associated with the facilities; wiring and electrical techniques, including installation, repair and maintenance; plumbing, carpentry and painting techniques and methodology; machines and tools including their designs, uses, repair and maintenance; swimming pool and spa maintenance principles. Ability to operate machines, power tools and hand tools associated with the job. Basic clerical skills, including word processing. Ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions. There are some risks which require the use of special safety precautions and/or equipment, such as working around operating machines. There are risks found in potentially dangerous or unusual environmental stress situations, e.g. working at great heights, working in extreme outdoor weather conditions, etc. Requires considerable and strenuous physical exertion such as frequent climbing of tall ladders, lifting heavy objects over fifty (50) pounds, crouching or crawling in restricted areas, etc. Must be able to lift and carry over fifty (50) pounds. Travel to various school sites is required. Must have a valid Utah driver license with clean driving record. Preference may be given to applicants certified to maintain a swimming pool in accordance with Utah State Department of Health requirements. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position.

SALARY AND BENEFITS Hourly rate \$10.41. Benefits will be limited to Social Security. This position is exempted by law from the provisions of competitive career service. The State requires employees to receive their pay through Direct Deposit or EPPICard.
