**JOB SUMMARY** Provides home-based services to families with young deaf/hard-of-hearing children, age birth to five years, in the areas of American Sign Language (ASL) and deaf culture; prepares and writes lesson plans; performs weekly home visits to children and families, following the curriculum provided, and models for parents the activities to be worked on with children during the week; helps families access deaf community activities and events; applies bilingual, bicultural teaching methods to young deaf/hard-of-hearing children; attends training sessions and workshops as assigned; performs other duties as assigned.

**JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS** Must be deaf, have advanced American Sign Language (ASL) skills, and have knowledge of deaf culture. Ability to deal with people in a manner which shows sensitivity, tact and professionalism; communicate clearly and effectively; maintain a high level of confidentiality. Preference will be given to applicants with a degree in Early Childhood Education and/or experience working with deaf/hard-of-hearing children. Travel is required; must have own transportation. Must be willing to work a schedule that meets the needs of the families being served, including evenings and Saturdays. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position.

**SALARY AND BENEFITS** State of Utah Step 28, \$11.29 per hour. Benefits will be limited to Social Security. This position is exempted by law from the provisions of competitive career service. The State requires employees to receive their pay through Direct Deposit or EPPICard.

**ASSIGNMENT PERIOD** This is a part time appointment. Work schedule five (5) hours per week, forty-two (42) weeks per year.
