JOB SUMMARY Interprets instructor's lectures, comments and questions for deaf/hard-of-hearing students in a mainstream classroom setting; interprets students' questions and statements; interprets for school functions as assigned; adapts signing level and system to the communication needs of the students; tutors as appropriate under the supervision of the classroom instructor; follows the code of ethics for certified interpreters; participates cooperatively as a member of the educational team; assists in coordinating note taking for students as needed; communicates regularly with instructors, program specialist and lead interpreter about student progress and concerns; follows schedule as determined by program specialist; is willing to improve signing skills through inservices and additional classes; performs other duties as assigned.

JOB REQUIREMENTS/SKILLS Must possess a current Intermediate Level Sign Language Certification from the Utah Certification Board, EIPA rating of 3.5 or higher, or equivalent certification. Successful completion of criminal background check is required for this position.

SALARY AND BENEFITS Salary commensurate with EIPA certification. This position is eligible for full benefits including medical, dental, life insurance, long term disability insurance, 1.5% employer contribution to 401(k), personal and sick leave, pension, and other valuable benefits. The State requires employees to receive their pay through Direct Deposit or EPPICard.

ASSIGNMENT PERIOD This is a time-limited, temporary position through the end of the current school year. Work schedule Monday through Friday, seven (7) hours per day.
