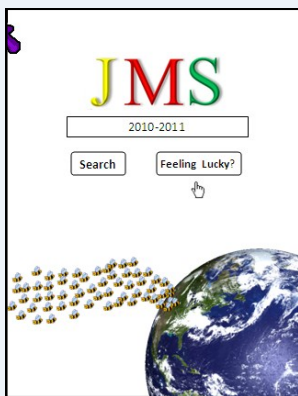


# Yearbook
