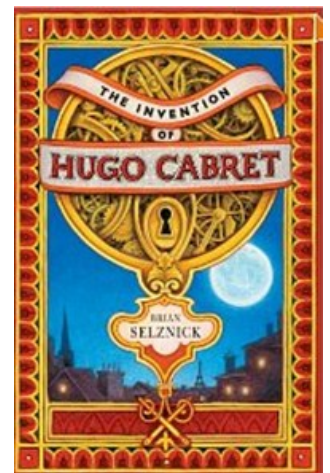
The Invention of Hugo Cabret

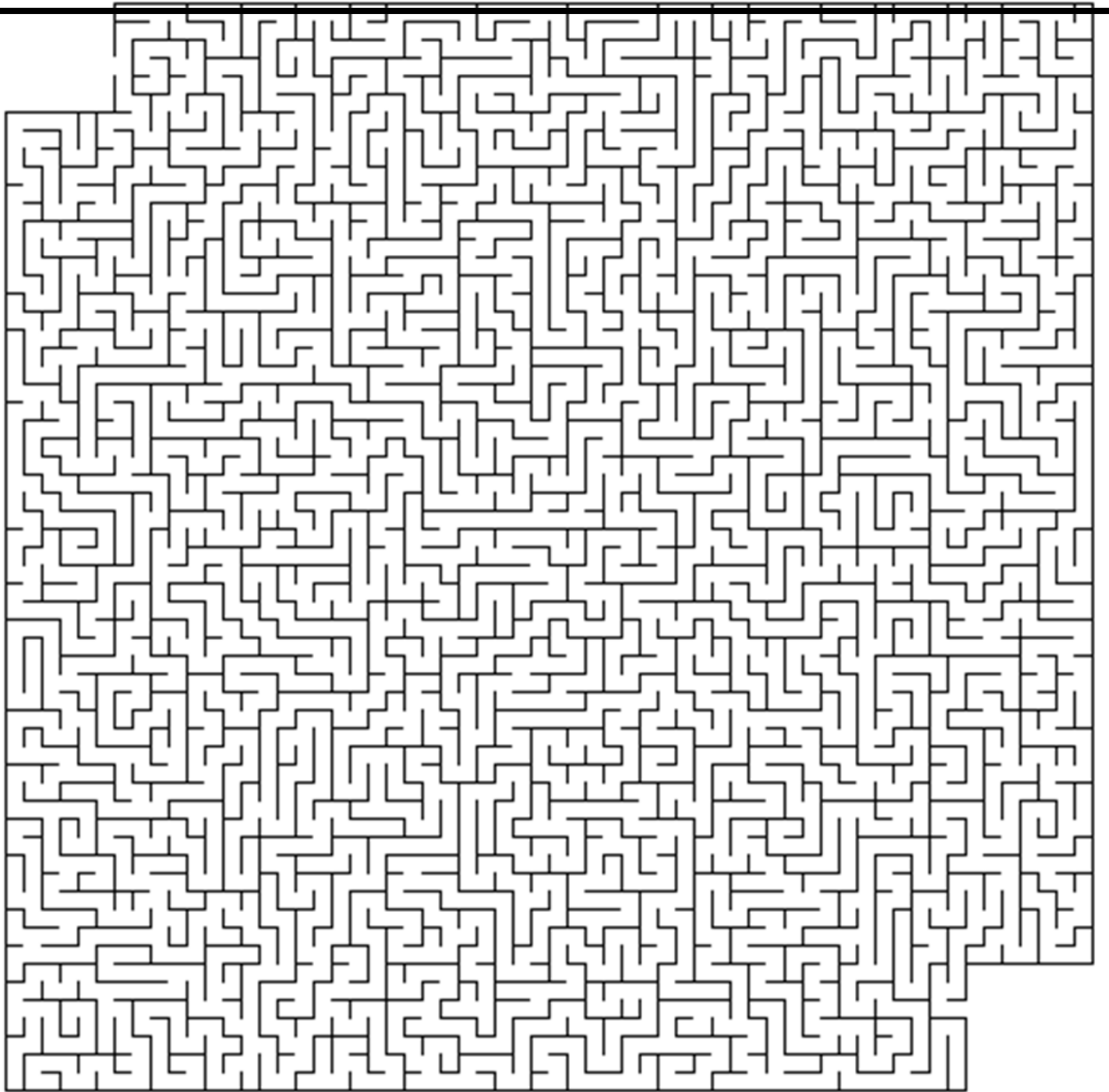

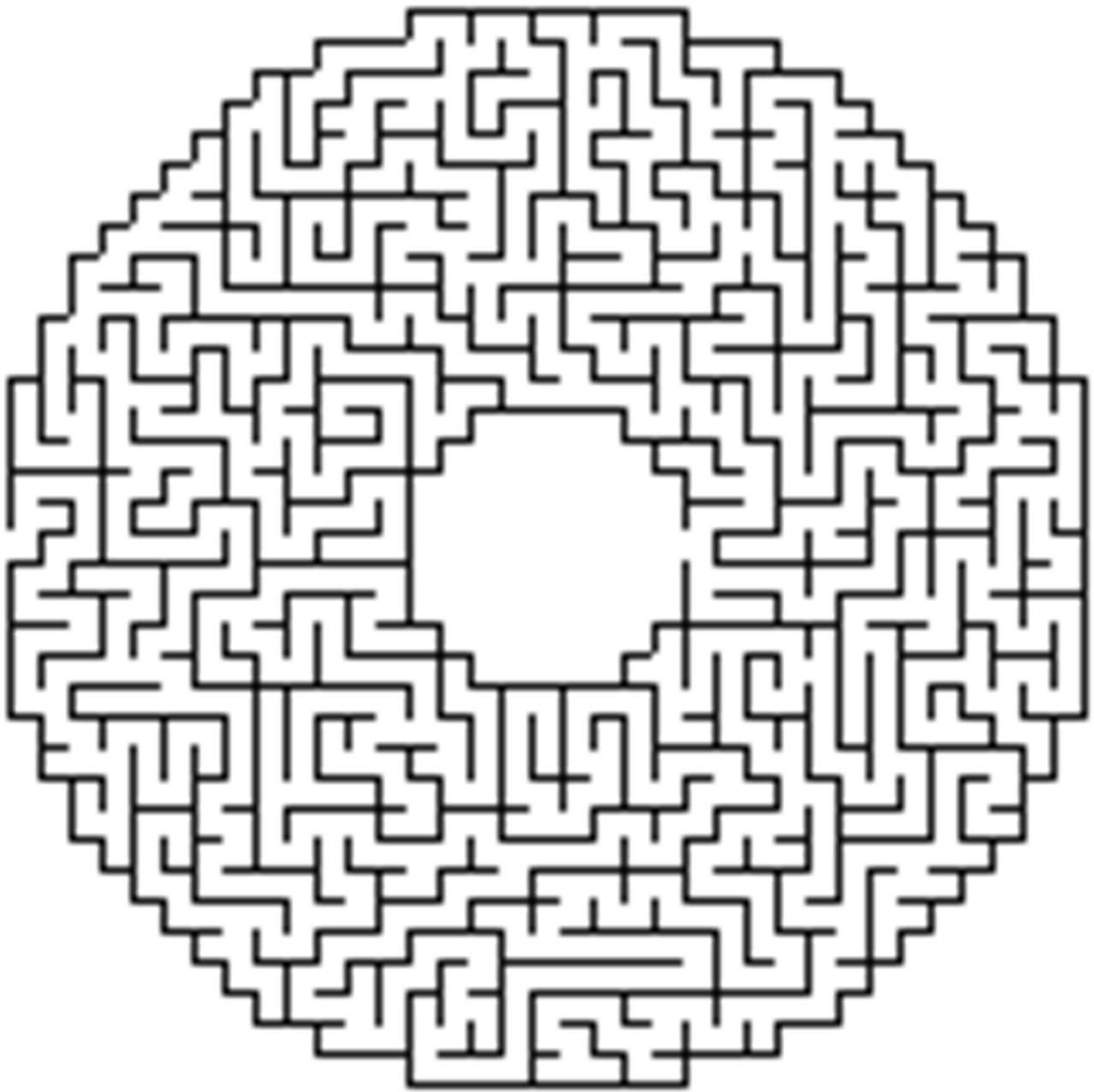
